Chorale Announces Young Composers Competition

As part of its dedication to the development of new choral music and the work of young choral composers, Los Robles Master Chorale has announced its first Young Artist Choral Composition Competition.

Southern California composers 35 years old or younger are invited to submit a new, original composition. The winning composer will be awarded a \$500 cash prize, and his or her composition will be performed by the chorale, under the direction of Artistic Director Lesley Leighton, at its May 7, 2011 concert in Thousand Oaks. Two honorable mentions, with a prize of \$100, may also be awarded.

The composer must reside in Los Angeles, Ventura, Orange, San Diego, Riverside, San Bernardino, or Santa Barbara counties. Submissions must be postmarked by December 1, 2010. No electronic submissions will be accepted.

The piece must be original (no arrangements) and never before performed or recorded, and it must be for a cappella, SATB choir. Performance length should be between three and five minutes.
